What happened to European Welfare Systems after the financial crisis? This book provides the first comprehensive analysis of how European Welfare Systems have developed since 2007, thereby covering not only the financial crisis, but also multiple challenges such as the demographic change and the balance of risk prevention and opening opportunities. Single-country studies (written by national experts) are complemented with comparative chapters. The core message is that, although European Welfare Systems are facing similar challenges, they are reacting to them in different ways, thus revealing that national diversity can still be considered one of the main characteristics of European Welfare Systems.
